



ACCESS FUNDING FOR CLASSROOM OR SCHOOL-BASED ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECTS

This project funding opportunity is offered for a limited time on a first-come, first-serve basis and you must create a virtual classroom to access the funding opportunity.

Important Information

- There are a limited number of funding subsidies, equitably allocated by province and territory, in the amount of \$250.00.
- The goals of the funding opportunities are to:
 - Increase student engagement in environmental learning and action;
 - Nurture a generation of caring and involved citizens; and
 - Strengthen school-community partnerships to ensure quality of life for all citizens.
- The objectives of the funding opportunities are to encourage students to:
 - Take action that builds on and strengthens their passion, commitment and caring for the environment;
 - Lead in creative and unique ways that increase their sense of self and awareness for others; and
 - Be recognized for the efforts and energy they invest in sustainable projects.
- Green Street reserves the right to highlight projects on its public Green Street Web site.
- All applications will be reviewed by a committee; responses will be provided to all applicants within three weeks of receipt of project application.

Rules

1. Funding subsidies are open to all elementary and secondary teachers and students across Canada in the K-12 public education system. One subsidy per school only.
2. You must register your virtual classroom before accessing the funding subsidies.
3. You must complete the online application form and adhere to the guidelines to ensure payment.
4. Projects must have the full signed endorsement of the school teacher or mentor, and the school principal.
5. Funding will be paid directly to the school to defray expenses to support the project.
6. A final report **MUST** be submitted to Green Street.
7. All projects should acknowledge “Green Street / Ma rue verte”, a not-for-profit program seeking to create a movement in schools centred on young people acting now and with other members of their community to create a sustainable future.

Support for teachers and students:

- The Green Street School platform provides a secure and open space to teachers and students to exchange ideas and find out what’s happening in other areas of their region, province and country.
- A Youth Mentorship opportunity through the Green Street Youth Advisory Committee and the Green Street Youth Action Centre.
