



## REGISTER YOUR *GREEN STREET VIRTUAL CLASSROOM*

You can register your elementary or secondary classroom(s) on the Green Street School platform to enable you and your students to exchange ideas and collaborate on projects of mutual interest.

### **Important Information**

- Green Street covers the fees for your license to this platform for one year.
- This is a non-partisan platform which will be monitored on a regular basis to ensure that it remains free of offensive or abusive language, personal attacks, and personal campaigns.
- Green Street adheres to a strict privacy policy and will not release any personal contact information gathered through the registration process.
- Green Street retains the right to send periodic email communications to all teachers registered on the School platform.

### **Rules**

1. The Green Street School platform is only open to elementary and secondary teachers and students across Canada in the K-12 public education system.
2. A teacher may register more than one classroom, and a number of teachers from the same school may register their respective classrooms.
3. You must complete the online registration form to activate your status and your classroom. If any information is missing, processing of the form will not be possible. **You must include your e-mail address! If the e-mail address is incorrect, we will not be able to accept your registration!**
4. Once your registration has been received, we will follow-up with an e-mail providing instructions for accessing your Virtual Classroom when it's ready to be used! Until then, you can return to the Green Street site [www.green-street.ca](http://www.green-street.ca).
5. Once you have access to the site, you can upload content, videos, photos, and other graphics and illustrations that support your ideas and your projects; you can dialogue with other classrooms and schools across the country; you can access resources and funding.
6. Your virtual classroom or school project description may be made visible to the general public on the public Green Street Web site.
7. You must adhere to the rules of respect. Green Street strives to encourage positive collaboration and engagement.
